

Siege of Bexar Descendants Membership Application

The Siege of Bexar Descendants was incorporated as a domestic non-profit Educational Organization with the Texas Secretary of State November 2, 1992 by Pat Hill Goodrich of Baytown, Texas. The organization later failed and its non-profit status was revoked sometime after 2009 due to failure to file required forms.

This organization is inactive - this form is obsolete and is for informational purposes only.

- The application must be signed and notarized.
- Include a check for \$31 made out to Siege of Bexar Descendants.
- Return the signed and notarized application, the proof documents and check to: Registrar, Siege of Bexar Descendants, -----, Kerrville, TX.

Membership Eligibility

Any person of good moral character who is a direct descendant of a veteran of the Siege & Storming of Bexar is eligible for membership in the Siege of Bexar Descendants organization. A deceased person otherwise qualified may hold Posthumous Membership.

The Siege of Bexar began in October of 1835 and the final Assault on San Antonio occurred 5-10 December of that year. It is also known by other names, e.g. "The Battle of Bexar" and "The Assault on San Antonio". A veteran is anyone who served there in any capacity as a member of the Texian army.
